



NOMINATION FORM FOR GOLDEN BAGEL AWARD HONOREES

The Golden Bagel Award event is an opportunity to recognize outstanding members of the community who are deserving of recognition — activists who have, through sports and other endeavors, made significant contributions to the quality of life in the Bay Area. We welcome nominations from throughout Northern California.

If you wish to nominate a candidate for the Golden Bagel Award:

- Your nomination should detail the contributions of the person you feel is deserving of the award.
- The nominee should have a Jewish identity, but the contribution is not necessarily restricted to the Jewish community (i.e. a basketball coach in a public school where the team does not consist of all Jews is eligible).

Any Jewish adult (male or female) in Northern California may be nominated or apply for the award. Criteria for eligibility:

One who identifies him- or herself as a Jew, or who acknowledges his or her Jewish heritage, or one who wants to reconnect with their Jewish ancestral identity.

Please send nominations or applications (no more than 150 words) stating why this person is worthy of recognition. Potential honorees may nominate themselves or other worthy adults.

Please include the following along with the nomination:

- A letter from a person who is familiar with the potential honoree acknowledging his or her contributions to the community (not to exceed 150 words).
- A list of athletic participation or community service, as well as short biography of the nominee and any extracurricular activities.
- Additional letters of recommendation (not to exceed three) from individuals who know the candidate well and who are in a capacity to objectively judge the nominee's inspiration.
