CRITERIA FOR APPLYING

- Must be a high school senior: a member of the graduating class of 2020.
- May be male or female.
- Must identify as a Jew, acknowledge one's Jewish heritage, or want to reconnect with one's Jewish ancestral identity (or be a non-Jewish student applying for the Dennis Brown Mensch Award).

APPLICATION PROCESS AND APPLICATION MATERIAL

Applicants may be nominated by themselves or by others. Applicants or people nominating a student shall include the following along with the nomination:

- A letter from the student who is applying for a scholarship (not to exceed 150 words).
- A letter from a person who is familiar with the student (not to exceed 150 words).
- A list of athletic participation signed by a coach or counselor.
- Transcript of grades up to date of application or nomination (must include verification stamp).
- A complete list of community service and extracurricular activities.
- Additional letters of recommendation (not to exceed three) from administrators, counselors, teachers, coaches, clergy, parents, etc.
- Aerial Gilbert applicants should have someone attest to the obstacle in one of their letters.
